

CITY OF SHELTON
BASIN 3 SEWER REHABILITATION PROJECT

Sealed bids for the above improvements will be received by the City Clerk of the City of Shelton, 525 West Cota Street, Shelton, Washington 98584 until 2:00 p.m., February 7, 2018, at which time the bids will be opened and read aloud in Meeting Room 1 at the Shelton Civic Center located at 525 West Cota Street. Bids received after the time fixed for Bid Opening will not be accepted or considered. The official time for determining whether a bid has been submitted in a timely manner is based on the time clock in the meeting room. Bids received prior to the deadline will be publicly opened and read aloud shortly after the deadline.

All bid proposals shall be accompanied by a proposal guarantee (certified or cashier's check or approved bond) payable to the City of Shelton in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the proposal price. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory performance bond within the time stated in the specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to the City of Shelton. No bid shall be considered unless accompanied by such bid proposal deposit.

The City of Shelton reserves the right to waive informalities in the bidding, accept a Proposal of the lowest responsible bidder, reject any or all bids, republish the Call for Bids, revise or cancel the work, or require the work to be done in another way if the best interest of the City is served.

The City of Shelton is an Affirmative Action/Equal Opportunity Employer and hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any Contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement Minority Business Enterprises/Women's Business Enterprises (MBE/WBE) will be given the full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation. The City of Shelton does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, religion, age, or disability in employment or the provisions of services. Voluntary numerical MBE/WBE goal of 10 percent MBE and 6 percent WBE has been established for this project. Achievement of the goals is encouraged. However, no minimum level of MBE/WBE participation shall be required as a condition of the contract award. Bids will not be rejected or considered non-responsive if they do not include MBE/WBE participation. Bidders may contact the Washington State Office of Minority and Women's Business Enterprise (OMWBE) to obtain information regarding certified firms.

The Contractor must comply with the minimum rates for state and federal wages whichever is higher for laborers and mechanics and subcontracts exceeding \$2,000 as determined by the Secretary of Labor in accordance with the provisions of the Davis-Bacon and Related Acts.

The project will include the following approximate quantities of major items:

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| 8-Inch- and 12-Inch-Diameter Gravity Sewer Pipe | 10,171 LF |
| 8-Inch- and 15-Inch Trenchless Pipe Rehabilitation | 5,870 LF |
| Manholes | 59 Each |
| Sewer Lateral Replacement or Reinstatement | 292 Each |

The Contractor will have 250 working days for the Schedule 1 and 50 working days for Additive Alternative Bid 2, if awarded, to complete the work in compliance with all applicable laws and regulations.

The Engineer's estimated range for this project is between \$5,500,000 and \$6,500,000. Written questions regarding the project may be directed to the Project Coordinator, Brooke Kilts, at brooke.kilts@sheltonwa.gov. No response will be made to questions unless they are submitted in writing, and received at least one week prior to the bid opening.

Notice of Requirement: Each Bidder, contractor, or subcontractor (hereinafter the Contractor) must fully comply with the requirements, terms and conditions of the City of Shelton Affirmative Action Plan including the goals for minority manpower utilization as to each construction trade it intends to use on this construction contract and all other construction work (both federal and non-federal) in the Shelton area during the performance of this contract or subcontract. The Contractor commits itself to the goals for minority manpower utilization contained herein and all other requirements, terms and conditions of these bid conditions by submitting a properly signed bid. The Contractor will appoint a company executive to assume the responsibility for the implementation of such requirements, terms, and conditions.
